



### COVID-19 Conditions of Use for the CIH Arena

**It is the responsibility of the contract holder to ensure that all participants are aware of and adhere to these protocols.**

1. All individuals will need to complete an online assessment prior to entering the facility. It is the **CONTRACT HOLDERS** responsibility to ensure that all their participants and spectators are properly screened. The Eastern Ontario health Unit recommends using the [COVID-19 customer screening](#). Any individual who fails the assessment screening is **NOT** permitted to enter the building.
2. Contract Holders must record the name and contact information of every participants, parents and spectators who enter the facility for each date on the contract and for each group accessing the space during the rental period. Records must be kept for at least one (1) month for the purpose of tracing in the event of a COVID-19 outbreak. The log must be made available to CIHA or the EOHU upon request.
3. Team sports, including games and scrimmages are allowed.
4. Contact sports are no longer prohibited. However, any person who is engaged in physical fitness training activities must maintain a physical distance of at least two meters from every other person in the establishment except from their caregiver or from members of the person's household. Here's an easier way of interpreting it for the scenarios that aren't clear cut. If the person's primary purpose is training, they are required to maintain physical distancing. Contact is permitted if the person's primary purpose is practicing a sport.
5. No dry land training or game warm up permitted inside the arena.
6. **It is the coaching staff/organizer's responsibility to ensure that minors make their way through the correct exits at the appropriate times to their parents waiting outside. Due to maximum capacity restrictions, parents are not permitted in the dressing rooms hallway.**
7. Spectators are allowed and must maintain physical distancing (2 meters) from those outside of their household (exception continues to apply for caregivers).
8. Maximum capacity is limited to 50% of the room with the exception of pad #1 which will be lower because of the maximum of 1,000 people allowed inside the facility. Signs with maximum capacity will be posted at designated areas within the facility. It is the Contract Holder responsibility to ensure the maximum capacity is respected. Spectators must exit the building promptly after the event to not overcrowd the lobby area.

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9. Any person who enters or uses the facility must maintain a physical distance of at least 2 meters from any other person who is using the facility. **All individuals must wear a mask at all-times inside the facility.** A mask is required in the dressing room and between the room and the ice surface, but is not required when on the ice. Coaches and staff are strongly encouraged to keep their mask on while on the bench.
10. A valid \$2 Million Liability Insurance Certificate naming the City or Clarence-Rockland and the CIH Academy as an additional insured is required. A copy of this certificate must be sent to [ciharena@cihacademy.com](mailto:ciharena@cihacademy.com) prior to the first rental date.
11. Change rooms will be assigned with a limited capacity per room. Special requests for rooms are not available and no changes are permitted. Showers will be open at a 50% capacity. It is recommended that participants arrive ready to play as much as possible. Participants will have access to the building/dressing room no more than **30 minutes** prior to their booking and must vacate the building **15 minutes** after their booking. NO LOITERING is allowed anywhere in the building.
12. The Contract Holder agrees to take attendance for each date on the contract and for each group accessing the space during the rental period and **records must be kept for one (1) month** for the purpose of tracing in the event of a COVID-19 outbreak.
13. Contract Holder must have a safety plan in place.
14. Staff greeter no longer required.
15. These conditions of use must be followed at all times; failure to comply may result in immediate removal from the facility, non-refundable ice cancellation and review of future contract bookings.
16. All individuals must comply with all current EOHU recommendations and directives related to COVID-19. Please visit [www.eohu.ca](http://www.eohu.ca) to learn more.
